AN ORDER CREATING THE HUMAN RESOURCE MERIT PROMOTION AND SELECTION BOARD (HRMPSB) OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF DAVAO ORIENTAL. SOLELY FOR THE SELECTION AND APPOINTMENT OF THE VACANT POSITION IN THE PROVINCIAL DISABILITY AFFAIRS OFFICE (PDAO).

WHEREAS, Section 80 (b) of Republic Act. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates the establishment of a Human Resource Merit Promotion Selection Board (HRMPSB) in every province, city or municipality;

WHEREAS, the Human Resource Merit Promotion Selection Board (HRMPSB) shall derive its composition pursuant to Section 80 (c) of the same Code, headed by the Local Chief Executive.

NOW THEREFORE, I, NELSON L. DAYANGHIRANG, Provincial Governor of Davao Oriental, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the creation of the Human Resource Merit Promotion Selection Board (HRMPSB) of the Provincial Government of Davao Oriental. For the purpose of appointment to the vacant position in the (PDAO) thus:

SELECTION 1.	Composition
Chairperson	- HON. NELSON L. DAYANGHIRANG Governor
Members	 2nd Level representative of the Provincial Government Employees Association (PGEA) 1st Level representative of the Provincial Dandy Macaubos (PWD Representative)

MR. ART BENJIE C. BULAONG, Provincial Administrator, is designated as the duly –authorized representative of the Chairperson and shall convene the Board in his stead.

The PHRMDO shall act as Secretariat of the PSB.

SECTION 2. Duties and Responsibilities

The Members of the HRMPSB shall:

- Assist the Local Chief Executive in the judicious and objective selection for employment in the Provincial Disability Affairs Office (PDAO).
- Formulate screening procedures and shall adopt criteria for evaluating candidates for employment of promotion in the local government service.
- Formulate policies on employee's welfare in accordance with Civil Service Laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 3. Effectivity

This order shall take effect immediately.
