

PLGU Davao Oriental Guidelines No. 4, s. 2020 on Coronavirus Disease (COVID 19)

March 13, 2020

In view of the issuance of Resolution No. 11 of the Inter-Agency Taskforce for the Management of the Emerging Infectious Diseases and having raised the Alert Status to CODE RED Sublevel 2 in the entire Philippines, Memorandum Order No. 13-B on travel restrictions of PLGU employees to Manila is hereby expanded and revised accordingly, as follows:

- All Barangay assemblies are hereby suspended following the recommendation of the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Emerging Infectious Diseases Resolution no. 11, s. 2020 released last March 12, 2020, and public gatherings and other similar activities are also discouraged;
- Punong Barangays are also hereby encouraged to organize their respective Barangay Health Emergency Response Teams as mandated in DILG Memorandum 2020-018. Furthermore, all Punong Barangays shall designate the following personalities in their respective barangays, to wit:
 - a. Barangay COVID Action Officer
 - b. Barangay Surveillance and Containment Officer
 - c. Barangay Health Promotion and Education Officer
- 3. The determination of these point-persons shall be entrusted to the sound discretion of the Punong Barangays;
- 4. Punong Barangays shall also designate or assign a barangay isolation unit in their area of responsibility which shall serve as a holding area for COVID PUIs while waiting for the transport to referral hospitals;
- 5. All Punong Barangays are also directed to monitor barangay arrivals. All arriving visitors from other countries as well as those arriving from areas within the Philippines that are considered red zones/areas shall be placed on home monitoring;
- 6. Following the aforementioned directive, all NLD Serbisyo Caravans are also suspended temporarily until the public emergency is lifted. Nonetheless, the delivery of basic services shall not be disrupted.

All issuances on COVID 19 shall be coursed through official channels by the Provincial Government of Davao Oriental.
