A RESOLUTION STRONGLY SUPPORT THE PROPOSED PROJECT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MATI, RE: "RECLAMATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE CITY OF MATI FISH PORT", LOCATED AT PUROK CALAGUNDIAN, BARANGAY CENTRAL, CITY OF MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Governor Nelson L. Dayanghirang submitted a letter, dated March 4, 2020, requesting the august body for the passage of an appropriate legislative action manifesting a strong support to the proposed project of the City Government of Mati, entitled: "Reclamation and Construction of the City of Mati Fish Port located in Calagundian, Barangay Central, of the same City";

WHEREAS, City Mayor Michelle N. Rabat has requested the support of the Honorable Governor, through her letter dated February 12, 2020, together with the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, for the proposed reclamation and construction of the said fish port;

WHEREAS, the proposed Fish Port shall be 5 hectares, located at Purok Calagundian, Barangay Central, City of Mati, and shall expand to 10 hectares to cater fish-related industries in the City;

WHEREAS, the City Local Government Unit of Mati conducted several multi-agency joint inspections on the proposed fish port, including the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) and Philippine Reclamation Authority (PRA), which led to its inclusion in the Proposed Developmental Projects for FY 2019. However, it was not included in the projects to be funded;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Mati, being the proponent, intends to capture the fish catch due to increasing local, tourist, regional and even global fish consumption by developing a fish port for cleaner unloading and reduced postharvest losses.

WHEREAS, the proposed project would benefit the fishing industry by generating more employment and entrepreneurial opportunities, and increase the local revenue generation both at the barangay and the city level;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Dante M. Caubang, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Louis N. Rabat, and Anacleto P. Macatabog, it was

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, **STRONGLY SUPPORT THE PROPOSED PROJECT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MATI, RE: "RECLAMATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE CITY OF MATI FISH PORT", LOCATED AT PUROK CALAGUNDIAN, BARANGAY CENTRAL, CITY OF MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL;**


