



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.33
Series of 2020

AN ORDER EXTENDING THE MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL UNTIL JULY 15, 2020 UNLESS LIFTED, MODIFIED OR WITHDRAWN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Executive Order No. 112 imposing an enhanced community quarantine in high-risk areas and a general community quarantine in other parts of the country and adopting the *Omnibus Guidelines* in the implementation thereof;

WHEREAS, the National Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Re-emerging Infectious Diseases has issued the *Omnibus Guidelines* on the implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with amendments as of June 25, 2020;

WHEREAS, the province of Davao Oriental will remain under Modified General Community Quarantine pursuant to the pronouncement from National Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Re-emerging Infectious Diseases;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Units are expected to act as stewards of local health systems, primary responders to the public health emergency, and to implement calibrated and people-centered response including primary to tertiary care in an integrated and coordinated manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Provincial Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, **I, NELSON L. DAYANGHIRANG**, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION.

The implementation of the Modified General Community Quarantine in the Province of Davao Oriental is hereby extended until 15 July 2020 unless otherwise modified or withdrawn.

SECTION 2. CURFEW HOURS

As agreed upon by all local chief executives of all city and municipal local government units in the Province of Davao Oriental the new curfew hours shall be from ten o'clock in the evening to four o'clock in the morning (10:00 pm to 04:00 am). Movement allowed beyond curfew hours shall only be those exempted in the Sangguniang Panlalawigan ordinance on curfew hours.

SECTION 3. EASING UP OF SOME QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS

With the introduction of the community integration and mobilization or barangay based COVID 19 response, some quarantine protocols shall be eased up.



- 3.1 Health screening at all provincial borders will now be discontinued including the use of embarkation forms. The screening will now be done at the barangay level under the No Losses in Disease (NLD): Kabarangay Kontra COVID 19 embodied in Executive Order No. 31, s. 2020;
- 3.2 The 09:00 am to 04:00 pm allowance for all vehicles entering the province shall now be abolished. Vehicles may now enter the provincial borders at any given time provided that these vehicles shall still follow the guidelines set forth by the Department of Transportation. Provided further that passengers will still follow minimum health standards such as physical distancing while inside the vehicle;
- 3.3 Public utility vehicles may now enter the provincial borders even on Saturdays and Sundays.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Order shall be found unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.

Previous issuances or parts thereof in conflict with or inconsistent to the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
