AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING THE PROVINCIAL JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY ADVISORY BOARD AND DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, on January 2, 1991, the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology was created thru Republic Act 6975 as a line Bureau under the Department of Interior and Local Government;

WHEREAS, mandated to direct, supervise and control the administration and operation of all district, city and municipal jails in the Philippines with pronged tasks of safekeeping and development of its inmates, officially classed as persons deprived of liberty;

WHEREAS, as stated in SECTION 61 of RA 6975 that "...the provincial jails shall be supervised and controlled by the provincial government within its jurisdiction...."

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government is implementing the whole of government approach in the continuing process of reform to ensure better government service;

WHEREAS, in the past years, there has been noticeable need for reform and transformation to ensure efficient and effective provincial jail management;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government realized that jail management and penology needs the expertise of other disciplines to help the Provincial Warden;

WHEREAS, there is a need to organize the Provincial Jail Management and Penology Advisory Board in the province to represented by respective offices, departments and agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NELSON L. DAYANGHIRANG, Provincial Governor of Davao Oriental, by virtue of the powers vested in me by laws so hereby execute thi executive order with the following:

Section 1- COMPOSITION

The Provincial Penology Advisory Board shall be composed of the following:

Provincial Governor	- Chairman
DILG- Davao Oriental	- Vice Chairman
701 st BDE AFP	- Member
DOPPO- PNP	- Member
DOJ	- Member
JUDICIARY	- Member
Academe	- Member
Religious Sector	- Member
Medical Professional	- Member
PCSU	- Member
Provincial Warden	- Ex- Officio Member



Section II- POWERS AND FUNCTIONS. The Provincial Penology Advisory Council shall:

1. The Board shall be responsible for its internal strengthening as to board governance;
2. The Board shall provide advice and service to the Provincial Warden for the efficient and effective management of the jail;
3. The Board shall provide advice and service to the governor for reform measures;
4. The Board shall engage with all its stakeholders for cooperation management;

Section III- MEETING AND QUORUM

1. Shall meet once a month. The first meeting shall be not later than two weeks after its approval.
2. A simple majority of members of the board shall constitute a quorum.

Section IV- SECRETARIAT

The board shall designate its secretariat.

Section V- REPEALING CLAUSE

All other Executive Orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any positions of the Executive Order, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section VI- EFFECTIVITY

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
