



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 26, SERIES OF 2021**

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE PROVINCIAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (PADAC) OF DAVAO ORIENTAL**

WHEREAS, the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates that the government shall promote the quality of life of the people;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code provides that the local government units shall pursue undertakings to improve morals and maintain peace and order among other equally significant concerns;

WHEREAS, the increasing use of illegal drugs has significantly contributed to the incidence of heinous crimes;

WHEREAS, the problem on illegal drugs has to be addressed much more effectively to help ensure community peace and harmony;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 98-227 dated December 2, 1998, 99-226 dated December 2, 1999 and 2001-90 dated July 25, 2001, as amended, enjoin local government units to create their Local Anti-Drug Abuse Councils;

WHEREAS, the vision of Philippine President His Excellency Rodrigo Roa Duterte of a drug-free country, Local Anti-Drug Abuse Councils are obliged to support and strengthen the government's war against illegal drugs;

WHEREAS, DILG-DDB Joint Memorandum Circular 2018-01, dated May 21, 2018, provided new composition of the Local Anti-Drug Abuse Councils to intensify its functionality and substantiate its capability to perform operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NELSON L DAYANGHIRANG, Provincial Governor of Davao Oriental, by virtue of the power vested in me by existing laws, do hereby order the reconstitution of the Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) with the following composition and functions;

**SECTION 2 – PROVINCIAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (PADAC) EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

The Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) Executive Committee shall be created and shall be composed of the following, namely:

Foregoing representations from the CSOs are on hold over capacity from previous PADAC, to avoid a hiatus in the private sector representations, provided, the said representations may be updated when the selection process as prescribed by DILG Memorandum Circular 2016-97 shall have been undertaken.

**SECTION 3 – DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE PROVINCIAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (PADAC)**

The Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) shall have the following duties and functions:

- a. serve as focal point through various organizations and individuals work together cooperatively in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programs on drug abuse prevention;



- b. provide effective mechanism for the coordination of existing services or programs and those which might be developed in the future;
- c. provide mechanism for obtaining funds, facilities and technical expertise;
- d. provide financial and technical assistance and support to component C/MADACs;
- e. create Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) Sub-Committee, if necessary, to assist the council in carrying out its programs and activities;
- f. ensure the formulation of PADAC Action Plan that contains the PPAs identified in the Municipal and City ADAC Action Plans;
- g. ensure the functionality of the lower ADACs;
- h. conduct of regular meetings once a month;
- i. supervise, analyze and review reports submitted by CADAC/MADAC Secretariat;
- j. submit all collated quarterly reports to the RPOC Secretariat not later than the 15th day of the ensuing quarter, copy furnished the Provincial Peace and Order Council and the DILG Provincial Office;
- k. ensure the establishment and operation of the Special Drug Education Center for out of school youth (OSY) and street children;
- l. provide support for the operationalization of the Community-Based Rehabilitation Program at the Municipality and Component Cities;
- m. conduct information and education campaign on the harmful effects of illegal drugs and monitor or report to proper authorities those drug peddlers and users in the locality; and
- n. perform other related responsibilities as may be assigned by competent authorities.

#### **SECTION 4 – PADAC ACTION OFFICER**

A PADAC Action Officer shall be designated by the Provincial Governor through a Memorandum Order to provide technical support to the council and shall be a member of the council.

When necessary or as may be directed by the PADAC Chairman, the Action Officer may call sub-committees to a meeting to treat urgent matters that need immediate action. At the instance of the council, the Action Officer shall provide necessary operational direction and shall report directly to the Provincial Governor.

#### **SECTION 5 – PADAC SECRETARIAT**

There shall be a designated Secretariat which shall provide secretariat services to the council. The said secretariat may be drawn from the staff of a local government office.



The Secretariat shall perform day-to-day tasks and responsibilities of the council.

It shall likewise cause the preparation of an Anti-Illegal Drug Abuse Program (AIDAP) accentuating on the problems to be addressed, activities or measures to address the problems, targets which may be defined in terms of the population sector or area(s) in the community that is to be covered, funding requirement, timeframe and the manifestations of measures of success, as well as Accomplishment, Monitoring and Exception Reports for decision-making and other purposes by the Council and other local and national authorities.

For operations support, the Secretariat shall derive its operational requirements from the PADAC Fund allocated for the purpose. As may be authorized by the Chairman, the regular members of the council may receive honoraria for the meetings attended.

PADAC Head Secretariat shall be designated through a separate memorandum order.

#### SECTION 6 – RULES ON MEETING

The Council shall determine specific schedule for its monthly meeting, as per DILG-DDB JMC 2018-01, and prescribe rules necessary in the conduct of such meetings.

#### SECTION 7 – REPEALING CLAUSE

All Executive Orders, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any provisions of this Executive Order, are hereby repealed, modified, and amended accordingly.

#### SECTION 8 – EFFECTIVITY

This Order shall take effect immediately.
