



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 32
SERIES OF 2021**

AN ORDER CREATING AND MOBILIZING THE PROVINCIAL TASK FORCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL FOR "OPLAN TABANG SIARGAO" PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION, ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, given the significance of coordinated efforts mechanism in times of disasters and emergency, there is a need to create a Provincial Task Force to OPLAN TABANG SIARGAO to ensure the wellbeing of affected individuals, families and communities;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Task Force of Davao Oriental for OPLAN TABANG for Siargao Island enable humanitarian actors to plan, establish and coordinate a set of minimum responses to affected families of Typhoon "Odette" in some regions of the country;

WHEREAS, the entire Province of Surigao del Norte was badly devastated brought about by Typhoon "Odette" wherein the Island of Siargao with nine (9) municipalities was the most affected as it was where the Typhoon "Odette" made its 1st landfall;

WHEREAS, there were 40,899 families or 115,051 affected population in the island with 23 reported deaths, 427 injured and 26 missing individuals. It was also reported that around 80% in the island is currently homeless (*PDRRMC Surigao del Norte Situational Report No. 17 dated December 26, 2021 at 1600H*);

WHEREAS, to show solidarity and humanitarian support to the people that were affected by Typhoon "Odette", the Provincial Government of Davao Oriental will initiate Oplan Tabang Siargao by bringing various social services of this Province to the people of Siargao Island as a form of humanitarian response to help alleviate the lives of the community brought by Typhoon "Odette";

NOW, THEREFORE I, NELSON L. DAYANGHIRANG, Provincial Governor of this Province, by virtue of power vested in me by law, do hereby order the creation and mobilization of Provincial Task Force Davao Oriental for "Tabang Siargao", to wit:

SECTION 1: COMPOSITION

The Provincial Task Force for "Tabang Siargao" shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

2.1. The PDRRMO will overall lead, establish strong and efficient coordination, assessment and mobilization for "*Oplan Tabang Siargao*".

2.2. Medical Team will facilitate, administer immediate diagnosis and establish effective systems for referring/supporting severely affected people and organize access to a range of support including psychological first aid to people in acute distress.

2.3. Shelter Assistance will carry out and mobilize essential available resources for repair/rehab, installation, construct in support to severely affected areas.

2.4. Secure the safety and orderly of the Provincial Team deployed performing tasks and its resources.

2.5. Facilitate the process of procurement and mobilization of relief goods (Food and Non-Food items) with proper turn-over and documentation to legitimate recipients of the affected areas.

2.6. Document all necessary activities while performing essential actions during the conduct of Oplan Tabang Siargao operation.

2.7. All logistical support should be administer by Local Finance Committee for the utilization of fund's availability.

SECTION 3. MOBILIZATION

The Provincial Task Force shall work and coordinate in a spirit of convergence to immediately mobilize and achieve the objective of this order in an efficient and effective manner.

SECTION 4. FUNDING

Funds necessary to support the implementation of this Order shall be appropriated upon the proposal's submission of each committee, evaluation and recommendation of the Local Finance Committee duly approved by the Executive Chairperson.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE

All orders, rules and regulations, and other issuance or parts thereof are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY

This order shall take effect immediately.
