**ESTABLISHING THE PROVINCIAL INTER-AGENCY COMMITTEE
ON CIVIL REGISTRATION AND VITAL STATISTICS**

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 1106 signed by President Benigno Aquino III officially declared the years 2015 to 2024 as the "Civil Registration and Vital Statistics Decade" in the Philippine, urging all relevant national government agencies – namely health, civil registration and statistics - to strengthen and improve civil registration and vital statistics activities, and the private sector, development institutions and the greater public to actively participate and support all programmes related to the "Get every Pinoy and Pinay in the Picture" initiative – a Philippine offshoot of the "Get everyone in the Picture" regional initiative in Asia and the Pacific;

WHEREAS, Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Board, chaired by the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA) issued PSA Board Resolution No. 12 Series of 2014 establishing the Committee on Civil Registration and Vital Statistics of the PSA

WHEREAS, the PSA Board issued PSA Memorandum Order No. 01 Series of 2015 establishing the Inter-Agency Committee on Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (IACCRVS) at the national level;

WHEREAS, the IACCRVS was organized to serve as venue for discussion and resolution of issues on CRVS, asserting that an efficient and effective CRVS supports national and local administrators to deliver services by helping them to identify what services are needed, where and by whom;

WHEREAS, Office Memorandum No. 2020-11 issued by Undersecretary Claire Dennis S. Mapa, Ph.D, National Statistician and Civil Registrar General urged the creation of the Sub-National IACCRVS;

NOW THEREFORE, by the powers vested in me by law, I, NELSON L. DAYANGHIRANG, Provincial Governor, do hereby order the creation of the Provincial Inter-Agency Committee on Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (IACCRVS) in Davao Oriental.

Section 1. Composition

The Provincial IACCRVS of Davao Oriental shall be composed of:

Chairperson:	Philippine Statistics Authority – Davao Oriental
Co-Chairperson:	Provincial Health Office – Davao Oriental
Members:	City Health Office of Mati Department of Education – Davao Oriental

Department of Education – City of Mati
Department of Justice – Davao Oriental
Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office - Davao Oriental
Department of the Interior and Local Government - Davao Oriental
Office of the Population Commission - Davao Oriental
National Commission on Muslim Filipinos
National Commission on Indigenous Peoples
President of League of MCRs in Davao Oriental (KATASSIDA, Inc.)

Section 2. Duties and Responsibilities

The specific functions of the Committee are as follows:

1. Serve as forum for the exchange of views and expertise to resolve technical issues and problems arising from the dissemination and use of civil registration and vital statistics;
2. Recommend to the PSA appropriate measures for the improvement of statistics, including the statistical methodologies and processes for the generation and dissemination of vital statistics, such as information on cause of death;
3. Recommend to the PSA an efficient and workable scheme for the allocation of agency responsibilities in the dissemination of vital statistics;
4. Reviews a multisectoral provincial CRVS strategy and solicit support for its implementation;
5. Reviews, develops, and proposes relevant legislations, policies, rules and regulations to address CRVS issues;
6. Recommends to the PSA the targets for the CRVS goals, aligned with the eight outcomes of the Regional Strategic Plan for the Improvement of Civil Registration and Vital Statistics in Asia and the Pacific;
7. Review statistical requirements of stakeholders in the Philippine Statistical System, such as prioritization of outputs required to carry out civil registration and vital statistics related programs and delineate the responsibilities of involved stakeholders; and
8. Serve as one of the educational avenues to improve primary health care.

Section 3. Effectivity

This Order shall take effect immediately upon signing thereof.
