A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 01. SERIES OF 2021, OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MANAY, DAVAO ORIENTAL, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY, SUBJECT TO SOME CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, series of 2021, of the Municipality of Manay, Davao Oriental, authorizing its CY 2021 General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 1, involving an appropriation of Five Million Two Hundred Ten Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Five (P 5,210,385.00) Pesos, was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on October 4, 2021, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160;

WHEREAS, the subject Appropriation Ordinance shows substantial compliance with the same law and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Anacleto P. Macatabog, duly seconded by SP Member Enrico M. Antopuesto, it was

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED:

RESOLVED, to declare Appropriation Ordinance No. 01, series of 2021, of the Municipality of Manay, Davao Oriental, **OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY**, as of its stated effectivity date, subject to the posting requirements under Section 59 of RA No. 7160, and subject further to the following conditions:

- a) The excess in the amount of P7,868,846.90 shall be reverted to Unappropriated Balance of the General Fund;
- b) Lump sum appropriations shall be subject to Sections 305 (b) and 335 of RA 7160, RA 9184 and its Revised IRR, and other existing pertinent laws, rules and regulations imposing restraints on government expenditures:
- In addition, Article 454 of the IRR of RA 7160 reiterates this mandate and provides further that disbursements from such special accounts under the General Fund shall proceed from itemized appropriations in the budgets of LGU instead of by lump-sum. Such itemized appropriations shall be for the specific development projects/activities embodied in the local development plan and/or public investment program formulated and prioritized by the LDC and approved by the Sanggunian concerned.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to inform the Municipality of Manay, Davao Oriental, that this review action does not authorize any item of appropriation that is specifically prohibited by or inconsistent with the provisions of law;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to send a copy of this Resolution to the Sangguniang Bayan of Manay, Davao Oriental, through the Municipal Mayor.
