A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 07, SERIES OF 2021, OF THE CITY OF MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY, SUBJECT TO SOME CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 07, series of 2021, of the City of Mati, Davao Oriental, authorizing its CY 2022 General Fund Annual Budget involving an appropriation of **One Billion Eight Hundred Five Million Six Hundred Eighty Four Thousand One Hundred Thirty Seven Pesos (P1,805,684,137.00)**, was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on December 16, 2021, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160;

WHEREAS, the subject Appropriation Ordinance shows substantial compliance with the same law and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Anacleto P. Macatabog, unanimously seconded by all members present;

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED:

RESOLVED, to declare Appropriation Ordinance No. 07, series of 2021, of the the City of Mati, Davao Oriental, **OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY**, as of its stated effectivity date, subject to the posting requirements under Section 59 of RA No. 7160, and subject further to the following conditions:

- a. The LGU, being a 5th class city, shall base its 3rd tranche salary increase in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 11466 as implemented by LBC No. 143, dated January 3, 2022;
- b. The implementation of programs/projects/activities pertaining to Gender and Development shall be in accordance with PCW-DILG-NEDA-DBM JMC No. 2016-01, dated January 12, 2016, implementing RA No. 9710 or the Magna Carta of Women, RA 7192 or Women in Dev't. and Nation Bldg. Act;
- c. The utilization of LDRRM Fund in the amount of P10,364,192.85 in the General Fund shall be subject to Section 324 (d) of RA 10121 and its implementing rules and regulations pursuant to NDRRMC-DBM-DILG JMC No. 2013-1, dated March 25, 2013, and other related issuances. It is understood that the LDRRM Plan shall be reviewed by the Office of Civil Defense per LBM 77, dated May 15, 2018;
- d. Implementation of programs/projects/activities under the 20% Development Fund shall be in accordance with DBM-DILG JMC No. 2017-01, dated February 22, 2017 and other relevant issuances/policies;
- e. Utilization of Confidential Funds shall be in accordance with DBM, DILG, GCG and COA Joint Circular No. 2015-01, dated January 8, 2015. Likewise, PPAs under the Peace and Order Fund shall be in accordance with DILG MC No. 2015-128, dated November 2, 2015, and other relevant policies and budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
- f. Implementation of the programs of the Local Councils for the Protection of Children shall be in accordance with RA No. 9344 or Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006;
- g. Implementation of PPAs for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities shall conform with DBM-DSWD Joint Circular No. 2003-01, dated April 28, 2003, pursuant to RA No. 9994 amending RA No. 7432 and RA No. 9442 amending RA No. 7277;
- h. Identification of Climate Change Expenditure Typologies of the PAPs in the Annual Investment Program (AIP) shall be consistent with DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Circular No. 2015-1, dated July 23, 2015. As required in the same circular, forms shall be submitted to the Climate Change Commission for review and consolidation, copy furnished DILG and DBM;
- i. Lump sum appropriations in Other Special Purpose Appropriations / Other MOOE / Capital Outlay shall be subject to Section 305 (b) and 335 of RA 9184 and its Revised IRR, and other existing pertinent laws, rules and regulations imposing restraints on government expenditures. Likewise

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purchase of Motor Vehicles (MVs) shall conform with the guidelines prescribed under NBC Nos. 446 and 446-A, dated November 24, 1995, and January 30, 1998, respectively; Budget Circular Nos. 2017-1 and 2010-2, dated April 26, 2017 and March 1, 2010, respectively; and Administrative Order No. 233, dated August 1, 2008, as amended by Administrative Order No. 15, dated May 25, 2011 and Administrative Order No. 14, series of 2018, undertaking Budget Circular No. 2019-2, dated March 4, 2019; Budget Circular No. 2019-3, dated May 16, 2019; Circular Letter No. 2019-9, dated July 11, 2019, and other related ensuing issuances regarding the purchase of MV and purchase of plane tickets pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 11-2017, dated March 10, 2017. Also, the LGU is reminded that an Authority to Purchase MV is a condition precedent before an Invitation to Bid is posted;

- j. It is understood that an Indicative Annual Procurement Plan (APP) has been attached to the Annual Budget CY 2022 in accordance with Sections 7.3.4 and 7.3.5 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184;
- k. LGUs shall record their financial transactions in accordance with the Revised Chart of Accounts for Local Government Units effective January 1, 2015, pursuant to COA Circular No. 2015-009, dated December 1, 2015;
- l. Payment of Magna Carta Benefits to Public Health Workers shall be consistent with the rules and regulations prescribed under DBM-DOH Joint Circular No. 1, series of 2012, dated November 29, 2012, as amended by DBM-DOH Joint Circular No. 1, series of 2016;
- m. It is understood that the funding requirements for the preparation and implementation of the LGU DTP, LGU CapDev Agenda, and LGU Communications Plan and Strategy shall be included and prioritized by the LGUs in their respective Annual Investment Programs (AIPs) and Annual Budgets pursuant to LBM No. 82, dated June 14, 2021. In addition, no PPAs shall be funded in the Annual and/or Supplemental Budgets if it is not included and/or in accordance with the Approved Annual and/or Supplemental Investment Program, pursuant to Section 305 (i) of RA 7160.
- n. The grant of Representation Allowance and Travelling Allowance (RATA) shall be in accordance with DBM LBC No. 103, dated May 15, 2013;
- o. In all cases, disbursements of appropriations herein authorized shall be subject to availability of funds and all accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to inform the City of Mati, Davao Oriental, that this review action does not authorize any item of appropriation that is specifically prohibited by or inconsistent with the provisions of law.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to send a copy of this Resolution to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Davao Oriental, through the City Mayor.

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

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
