A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN AM RADIO STATION IN THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL, TO **INFORMATION** STRENGHTEN DISSEMINATION, SUSTAIN EFFORTS ON PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT, AND CREATE DISASTER-RESILIENT COMMUNITIES, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATIVE THERETO.

WHEREAS, the value of radio broadcasting has long been known as a crucial platform not only in disseminating information and promoting advocacies, but more importantly, in providing life-saving information in times of disasters and emergencies, as well as sustaining peace and development, especially for those communities vulnerable to conflict:

WHEREAS, the government continues to strive to find ways for communication platforms, such as the radio, to do even more to help people during responses to the increasing number of emergencies and disasters facing the world considering that it can be a lifeline in times of crisis and emergency:





WHEREAS, radio broadcast communication is a powerful tool that continues to promote dialogue, tolerance and peace as it addresses crucial social issues at the community level;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned standpoint is also shared by the national government, which aims to strengthen the capacity of the local government units (LGUs), together with partner stakeholders, to build the disaster resilience of communities, and to institutionalize arrangements and measures for reducing disaster risks, including projected climate risks, and enhancing disaster preparedness and response capabilities at all levels, as stated under Section 2 (e) of the RA 10121 (An Act Strengthening the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management System, Providing for the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Framework and Institutionalizing the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan.);

WHEREAS, under Section 486 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Provincial Local Government Unit, through its Information Office is mandated to provide relevant, adequate, and timely information to the local government unit and its residents;

WHEREAS, seeing the value of information and the significance of radio broadcast, especially in the current setting wherein disasters, challenges on peace and order and public health are prevalent, the Provincial Government of Davao Oriental has resolved to strengthen information dissemination through the establishment of an AM Broadcast Radio Station;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Davao Oriental has included in its list of Big-Ticket Projects the Establishment of the Davao Oriental AM Radio Station funded through loan proceeds under the Land Bank of the Philippines;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Louis N. Rabat, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Eleuterio C. Manaytay and Rabsalon M. Lamaran, it was

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, ESTABLISHING AN AM RADIO STATION IN THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL, TO STRENGHTEN INFORMATION DISSEMINATION, SUSTAIN EFFORTS ON PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT, AND CREATE DISASTER-RESILIENT COMMUNITIES, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATIVE THERETO;
