WHEREAS, the recent Low-Pressure Area affecting the entire Davao Region has brought heavy downpour to the entire Municipality of Cateel, causing a widespread and heavy flooding thereby triggering landslides, damaging agricultural crops and livestock, and destroying infrastructures, residential houses, and other properties;

WHEREAS, 80% of the families in the said municipality, or a total of 16,696 families, were directly affected, with the majority currently staying in evacuation centers and reported deaths during the flooding;
