A RESOLUTION COMMENDING POLICE PROVINCIAL DIRECTOR, PCOL EFREN EBRADA ORLINA, FOR HIS REMARKABLE LEADERSHIP AND ACTIVE ROLE IN SPEARHEADING NUMEROUS HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF DAVAO ORIENTAL, AS MANIFESTED IN HIS OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE IN LEADING THE POLICE OFFICE IN PURSUING PEACE AND ORDER, PROGRESS, AND RESILIENCE THROUGHOUT THE PROVINCE.

WHEREAS, the Davao Oriental Police Provincial Office, under PD Efen E. Orlina, continuously strives in achieving drug-free communities through supply reduction efforts involving strong law enforcement with the support of all the stakeholders in the province. Thus, it perpetually maintains and establishes adequate training to the uniformed personnel to enhance their knowledge and skills needed in the exercise of their profession. As an effect, the Office was able to successfully conduct 93 anti-illegal drug operations that resulted into the confiscation of 169.9726 grams of shabu and 13,444.74 grams of marijuana with an estimated DDB of PHP 6,919,182.10, arresting 117 drug personalities;

WHEREAS, the PNP in the Province persistently conducted aggressive police operations and "OPLAN KATOK", targeting unregistered and unlicensed firearms in the hands of threat groups, criminal elements, and the civilians – as well as firearms with expired or unexpired licenses. DOPPO had 224 operations conducted that resulted in the arrest of 63 personalities and the confiscation of 257 loose firearms, whereby contributing in maintaining peace and order and protecting the community from violence;

WHEREAS, on the campaign against illegal logging, DOPPO conducted a total of 54 operations that resulted in the arrest of 25 personalities, confiscation/recovery of 46,215 board ft. of wood and 361 fitches, amounting to Php2,219,670.00. Additionally, in the campaign against illegal fishing, DOPPO conducted a total of 31 operations that resulted to the arrest of 100 personalities, effectively seized 174.4 kilos of fish, 164 paraphernalia, and filed 5 cases in court;

WHEREAS, Provincial Director Efren E. Orlina was instrumental in the strong tie up between the Philippine National Police and the various schools and institutions throughout the Province through a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), two of which were Don Enrique Lopez National High School (DELNHS), and Davao Oriental State University (DORSU) for extension programs, research and development, which aims to strengthen community development. The DOPPO Mobile Forces has also been in constant collaboration with the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) for their Internal Security Operations (ISO) activities in suppressing insurgency and other serious threats to the National Security;

WHEREAS, as head of the Provincial Police Office, he was able to boost the morale and upkeep of the personnel he lead of his duration on duty, with a total of 147 personnel promoted. Five (5) PCOs promoted to Police Lieutenant Colonel (PLTCOL), two (2) promoted to Police Lieutenant, and 140 PNCOs promoted to next higher rank (PCPL – PEMS);

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Nelson R. Dayanghirang, Jr., duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Rabsalon M. Lamarin and Rustan R. Castellones, it was




