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EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 7 SERIES OF 2022

“AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (PDRRMC) AND DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS, DUTIES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate and House of Representatives enacted Republic Act 10121 otherwise known as the “*Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010*”;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of RA 10121 states that it is the policy of the state to uphold the people’s constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the cause of vulnerabilities to disasters, strengthening the country’s institutional capacity for disaster risk reduction and management, and building the resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;

WHEREAS, Rule 5 of the Implementing Rules and Regulation of RA 10121 provides for the organization of a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) at the local government level;

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to adopt a disaster risk reduction and management approach that is comprehensive, integrated, and proactive in lessening the socioeconomic and environmental impacts of disasters including climate change and disease outbreaks, and engage and promote the involvement and participation of all Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), the private sectors, volunteers, all stakeholders concerned, and the community;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute and update the membership of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council of this Province to the attainment of goals, vision, missions, and objectives of the council;

NOW, THEREFORE I, CORAZON NUÑEZ MALANYAON, Provincial Governor of this Province, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (PDRRMC), as follows:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION – The membership of the PDRRMC shall be composed of the following:

Foregoing representations from the CSOs are on hold over capacity from the previous PDRRMC, to avoid hiatus in the private sector representations, provided, that said representations may be updated when the selection process as prescribed by DILG MC No. 2016-97 shall have been undertaken.

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF PDRRMC – As provided under Section 11 (b) of RA 10121 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, the following are the functions of the Council:

- 2.1 Approve, monitor, and evaluate the implementation of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (PDRRMP) and annually review, test, and develop the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
- 2.2 Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs, budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
- 2.3 Recommend the implementation of Pre-Emptive and Forced evacuation of local residents, if necessary;
- 2.4 Convene the local council once every three (3) months or as often as necessary;
- 2.5 Perform such other functions that are incidental to and are necessary for the performance of disaster risk reduction and management;
- 2.6 The Provincial DRRM Officer shall serve as the PDRRMC Secretariat; and
- 2.7 All PDRRMC member agencies shall assign and designate their permanent DRRM Focal Person.

SECTION 3. CREATION OF FOUR (4) THEMATIC AREA CLUSTERS – There shall be created four (4) Thematic Area Clusters under the PDRRMC and shall be headed by the following:

Thematic Clusters	Vice Chairperson
3.1 Disaster Prevention and Mitigation –	Provincial Env't & Natural Resource Officer
3.2 Disaster Preparedness –	Provincial DRRM Officer
3.3 Disaster Response –	Provincial Social Welfare & Dev't. Officer
3.4 Disaster Rehabilitation & Recovery–	Provincial Planning & Development Officer

Vice chairpersons shall be responsible in choosing their Thematic Cluster members aligned with their agencies' mandates.

SECTION 4. DUTIES AND FUNCTION OF THEMATIC AREA CLUSTERS – Respective thematic clusters shall have the following functions:

4.1 Conduct cluster meeting once every three (3) months prior to the conduct of PDRRMC meetings or as often as necessary;

4.2 Provide inputs on DRRM-CCA development plans aligned with their agencies' mandates;

4.3 Work with other implementing partners within the context of coordination, collaboration and partnership; and

4.4 Consolidate accomplishment reports of cluster members and implementing partners and submit/present during the PDRRMC meetings.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE – All previous Executive Orders inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY – This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless revoked or amended accordingly.
