A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 535, SERIES OF 2022, OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ON COLLECTION OF CORRESPONDING BARANGAY CLEARANCE FEE IN THE APPLICATION FOR ANY BUSINESS-RELATED TRANSACTIONS", CONSIDERING THAT THE SAME IS ACCORDANCE WITH LAW.

WHEREAS, the said City Ordinance was passed in compliance to DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-177, re: "Guidelines in the Integration of the Issuance of Barangay Clearance in the Permitting Processes of Cities and Municipalities";

WHEREAS, the Ordinance is also in line with the RA 11032 or the Ease of Doing Business of 2018 otherwise known as "An Act Promoting Ease of Doing Business and

Efficient Delivery of Government Services", an act that aims to streamline the current systems and procedures of government services;

WHEREAS, upon premises considered, this August Body hereby recommends the following:

- a. To consider favorable endorsement from the barangay government in securing the approval of business permits in their jurisdiction:
- b. To look into other laws that would not preclude other government issuances and other existing laws prior to this Act;
- c. To come up with an Implementing Rules and Regulations specifically to look into the effective delivery and the timely release or remittance of barangay clearance fees collected.
