A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TO THE PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE (PDC-EXCOM). THRU ITS CHAIRPERSON. THE HEREIN REQUEST OF FORMER CONGRESSMAN JOEL MAYO Z. ALMARIO, 2ND DISTRICT, DAVAO ORIENTAL, SEEKING SUPPORT FROM THIS HONORABLE BODY THROUGH A RESOLUTION ON THE PROPOSED CONVERSION OF THE DORSU ROAD, DON MARIANO MARCOS-MACANGAO ROAD, AND MATI-**TARRAGONA** ROAD INTO **NATIONAL** ROADS. FOR WHATEVER RECOMMENDATION AND GUIDANCE DEEMED APPROPRIATE THEREON.

WHEREAS, Former Congressman Joel Mayo Z. Almario, 2nd District, Davao Oriental, in his letter, dated June 8, 2022, to Former Governor Nelson L. Dayanghirang, through the 16th Sangguniang Panlalawigan, requested a resolution endorsing the proposed conversion of the following Local Roads into National Roads, described hereunder:

GUALUX Cymalanyaon

DORSU Road (Jct. Pres. Diosdado P. Macapagal Highway to DORSU Road)	1.87 km
Don Mariano Marcos – Macangao Road (Don Mariano Marcos - Malig - Calasagan - San Isidro - New VIsayas - Tagboa - Macangao Road)	31.055 Km
Mati - Tarragona Road (Mati - Tarragona Bypass Road)	3.471 Km

WHEREAS, R.A. 7160 is mandating the LGU to strengthen the planning and coordinating relationship between the local development council and Sanggunian on actions relative to policy issues, programs, projects and other development interventions. Hence, the PDC is requested to provide the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the specific recommendation or guidance as basis for the wise and more expedient disposition concerning the request of Former Congressman Joel Mayo Z. Almario;
