A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2022-06, OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LUPON, DAVAO ORIENTAL, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE VIII OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2021-27, SPECIFICALLY ON SECTION 81(B) NATURE OF BUSINESSES THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED TO OPERATE IN THE LUPON OVERLAND TRANSPORT INTEGRATED TERMINAL (LOTIT)", SUBJECT TO THE EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATIVE THERETO.

**WHEREAS,** Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, states that: "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. xxx";
