**WHEREAS**, Ms. Ludivina T. Mas, Executive Assistant V, City Mayor’s Office, City of Mati, Davao Oriental, submitted Executive Order No. 58, series of 2022, for review and appropriate action of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 58, series of 2022, was issued by the City Mayor Michelle N. Rabat on July 28, 2022;

**WHEREAS**, the said Executive Order is issued purposely to adopt the guidelines set by the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) and Department of Agriculture (DA) on the movement of live poultry, its products and by products in the City of Mati, to control the spread of Avian Influenza (AI), and facilitate the recovery of the livestock industry, particularly the poultry sector;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Agriculture (DA) issued Memorandum Circular Nos. 6, 12, 16, and 27, all series of 2022, which provide guidance and movement restrictions in poultry-related commodities across the different regions in the Philippines;
