PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 17-05-09-2022

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ASSISTANT DEPARTMENT HEAD (PGADH) (SG-24) UNDER THE PROVINCIAL TOURISM OFFICE, THIS PROVINCE.

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive has requested the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to pass an ordinance for the above-stated subject matter;

WHEREAS, the creation of the aforementioned position will merit to the effectiveness and efficiency of the Provincial Tourism Office in ensuring the development of the Philippine Tourism that is for and by the Filipino people in conserving and promoting their heritage, national identity, and sense of unity; recognizing sustainable tourism development as integral to the national socio-economic development effort to improve the quality of life of the Filipino people, especially of the Oriental Dabawenons; and promoting a tourism industry that is ecologically sustainable, responsible, participative, culturally sensitive, economically viable, and ethically and socially equitable for local communities of Davao Oriental;

WHEREAS, Section 76 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that: *“Every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission”*;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Marietta D. Palmera, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Harold A. Montes, Ronald T. Lara, Jr., Stephen Paul L. Uy, Art Benjie C. Bulaong, Andy A. Monday, and Eleuterio C. Manaytay, it was

Be it ordained by the 17th Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Davao Oriental, in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. CREATIONS OF POSITION – the creation of the position of **PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ASSISTANT DEPARTMENT HEAD (PGADH)** under the Provincial Tourism Office, with Salary Grade 24, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. IMPLEMENTATION – the implementation and execution of this Ordinance shall be subject to the existing and applicable Civil Service Laws, Rules and Regulations and shall be in accordance with relevant budget circulars of the Department of Budget and Management and other pertinent laws thereof.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE – all existing measures with a provision or provisions which are inconsistent with this ordinance, the same are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – Should any provision of this Ordinance is found invalid and declared unconstitutional, the rest of the provisions not otherwise affected shall remain effective and enforceable.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY – this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval hereof.





