**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ABOLITION AND CREATION OF VARIOUS PLANTILLA POSITIONS IN THE DIFFERENT OFFICES OF THIS PROVINCE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Local Chief Executive has requested the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to pass an ordinance abolishing and creating various plantilla positions in the different offices of this province;

**WHEREAS**, the said request is deemed necessary to ensure that all positions remain relevant, functional and properly attuned to the present dynamics for the effectiveness and efficiency of public service delivery;

**WHEREAS**, Section 76 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that: “Every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission.”;

**WHEREFORE**, on motion of SP Member Marietta D. Palmera, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Daud V. Linsag, Rotchie M. Ravelo, Harold A. Montes, Shella Marie S. Go, Stephen Paul L. Uy, and Ronald T. Lara, Jr., it was

Be it ordained by the 17<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Davao Oriental, in session duly assembled that:

**SECTION 1. ABOLITION OF POSITIONS** - the following positions are hereby approved for abolition:

**A) Provincial Governor's Office**

- One (1) Private Secretary II (SG-15)
- Three (3) Sr. Administrative Assistant III (SG-15)

**B) Provincial Treasurer's Office**

- One (1) Local Treasury Operations Officer III (SG-18)
- One (1) Local Revenue Collection Officer II (SG-15)
- One (1) Revenue Collection Clerk II (SG-7)
- Two (2) Revenue Collection Clerk I (SG-5)
- One (1) Administrative Officer III (SG-14)
- One (1) Administrative Assistant II (SG-8)
- Two (2) Administrative Aide VI (SG-6)

**C) DOPH – Manay**

- One (1) Administrative Officer II (SG-11)

Funding of the abolished positions shall be reverted to Unappropriated Balances of the CY 2023 General Fund of this province.

**SECTION 2. CREATION OF POSITIONS** - the following permanent plantilla positions are hereby approved for creation:

**A) Provincial Administrator's Office**

- Two (2) Administrative Aide III (SG-3)

**B) Provincial Treasurer's Office**

- One (1) Provincial Government Assistant Department Head (SG-24)
- One (1) Supervising Administrative Officer (SG-22)
- One (1) Local Revenue Collection Officer IV (SG-22)

**C) Provincial Social Welfare & Development Office (PSWDO)**

- One (1) Social Welfare Officer IV (SG-22)

**D) DOPH – Manay**

- Two (2) Administrative Aide I (SG-1)

Funding of these positions shall be included in the CY 2023 General Fund Annual Budget of this Province.

**SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE** – all existing measures with a provision or provisions which are inconsistent with this ordinance, the same are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.

**SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** - Should any provision of this Ordinance is found invalid and declared unconstitutional, the rest of the provisions not otherwise affected shall remain effective and enforceable.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY** - this Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2023.
