A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SECRETARY, VICE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, SARA ZIMMERMAN DUTERTE-CARPIO THRU THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR, ALLAN G. FARNAZO, CESO IV, OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, REGION XI, TO ESTABLISH AT LEAST ONE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL WITH COMPLETE K-12 STRANDS IN EVERY CLUSTERED BARANGAYS PER MUNICIPALITY, INCLUDING ONE COMPONENT CITY, IN THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL.

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 1, of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that: *“The State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all”;*

WHEREAS, the implementation of the K-12 Basic Education Program is considered to be one of the most educational reforms in the country, which aimed to expand and improve the delivery of basic education and provide the learners with the necessary skills and competencies;

WHEREAS, considering that some Senior High Schools in the province of Davao Oriental does not offer complete strands such as General Academic (GA), Humanities and Social Sciences (HUMMS), Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), Accountancy, Business and Management (ABM) in which some students have no access on the track of their choice as they required to go through a core curriculum of the K to 12 Basic Education Program;

WHEREAS, there is a need to identify a school within a clustered barangay which is accessible to all;

WHEREAS, in order to provide accessible education at all levels, especially in rural communities and continue their education at a lesser cost, it is deemed necessary to establish the same;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Harold A. Montes, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Rotchie M. Ravelo, Stephen Paul L. Uy, Rustan R. Castellones, Ronald T. Lara, Jr., Art Benjie C. Bulaong, Marietta D. Palmera, and Shella Marie S. Go, it was

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, **REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SECRETARY, VICE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, SARA ZIMMERMAN DUTERTE-CARPIO THRU THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR, ALLAN G. FARNAZO, CESO IV, OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, REGION XI, TO ESTABLISH AT LEAST ONE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL WITH COMPLETE K-12 STRANDS IN EVERY CLUSTERED BARANGAYS PER MUNICIPALITY, INCLUDING ONE COMPONENT CITY, IN THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL;**


