A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 69, SERIES OF 2022, ISSUED BY THE HONORABLE MICHELLE N. RABAT, CITY MAYOR OF MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL, RE: "SETTING THE SPEED LIMITS FOR ALL KINDS OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF MATI, PROVIDING FOR ITS SANCTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES", CONSIDERING THAT THE SAME IS WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED POWERS OF THE CITY MAYOR PURSUANT TO ARTICLE I, SECTION 455(b)(2)(iii) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 OR REPUBLIC ACT 7160.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Chapter IV, Article 1, Section 35(a) of Republic Act 4136, which states that: "*Any person driving a motor vehicle on a highway shall drive the same at a careful and prudent speed, not greater nor less than is reasonable and proper, having due regard for the traffic, the width of the highway, and of any other condition then and there existing; and no person shall drive any motor vehicle upon a highway at such a speed as to endanger the life, limb and property of any person, nor at*

a speed greater than will permit him to bring the vehicle to a stop within the assured clear distance ahead”;

WHEREAS, City Mayor Michelle N. Rabat, issued the foregoing Executive Order on the 9th day of August 2022, in the interest of public safety and preclude traffic accidents resulting from over speeding and reckless driving;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Daud V. Linsag, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Shella Marie S. Go, Harold A. Montes, Rotchie M. Ravelo, Stephen Paul L. Uy and Ronald T. Lara, Jr., it was


