RECONSTITUTION OF THE PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (PDC)

WHEREAS, Section 106, Title 6 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the creation of the Provincial Development Council to assist the *Sangguniang Panlalawigan* in setting the direction of economic and social development, and coordinating development efforts within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 107, Title 6 of the Local Government Code mandates that representatives of non-governmental organization operating in the province shall constitute not less than one-fourth (1/4) of the members of the fully organized council;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the Provincial Development Council to conform with the provisions of the Local Government Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, I CORAZON N. MALANYAON, Provincial Governor of Davao Oriental, by virtue of the power vested in me by existing laws do hereby order the reconstitution of the **Provincial Development Council** with the following composition and functions.

Section 1 – Composition

The Provincial Development Council shall be composed of the following:

Foregoing representations from the CSOs are on hold over capacity from the previous PDC, to avoid hiatus in the private sector representations, provided, that said representations may be updated when the selection process as prescribed by DILG MC No. 2022-083 shall have been undertaken.

Section 2 – Functions

The Provincial Development Council shall exercise the following functions:

1. Formulate long-term, medium-term, and annual socio-economic development plans and policies;
2. Formulate the medium-term and annual public investment program;
3. Appraise and prioritize socio-economic development programs;
4. Formulate local investment incentives to promote the inflow and direction of private investment capital;
5. Coordinate, monitor and evaluate the implementation of development programs and projects;
6. Perform such other as may be provided by law or component authority.

Section 3 – Executive Committee, Composition and Functions

An Executive Committee is hereby organized to represent the Provincial Development Council and act in its behalf when it is not in session. The composition shall be as follows:

The Executive Committee shall exercise the following powers and functions:

1. Ensures that the decision of the Council are faithfully carried out and implemented;
2. Acts on matters requiring immediate attention or action by the council;
3. Formulates policies, plans, and programs based on the general principles laid down by the council; and
4. Acts on the matters that may be authorized by the council.

Foregoing representations from the CSOs are on hold over capacity from the previous PDC, to avoid hiatus in the private sector representations, provided, that said representations may be updated when the selection process as prescribed by DILG MC No. 2022-083 shall have been undertaken.

Section 4 – Sectoral or Functional Committee

The Provincial Development Council may form sectoral or functional committees to assist them in the performance of their functions.

Section 5 – Secretariat

There shall be constituted a Secretariat headed by the Provincial Planning & Development Coordinator which shall be responsible for providing technical supports and documentation, preparation of reports and such other assistance as maybe required in the discharge of its functions. The composition shall be as follows:

Section 6 – Meetings and Quorum

The Provincial Development Council shall meet at least once every semester or as often as maybe necessary. A simple majority shall constitute a quorum.

Section 7 – Repealing Clause

All Executive Orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any provisions of this Executive Order, are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

Section 8 - Effectivity

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
