



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 11 DATED AUGUST 17, 2022 BY CHANGING THE MEMBER - CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) OF THE PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (PDC)

WHEREAS, in adherence to Department of the Interior & Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 2022-083, the Province, DILG and accredited CSOs conducted a meeting last September 9, 2022 for the selection of representatives to the Local Special Bodies (LSBs);

WHEREAS, it was cited in Section 1-Composition of Executive Order No. 11 Series 2022, that the representation from the CSOs are on hold over capacity from the previous PDC, to avoid a hiatus in the private sector representations, provided that said representations may be updated when the selection process as prescribed by DILG MC No. 2022-083 shall have been undertaken;

WHEREAS, during the selection process, it was agreed that the new CSOs members of the PDC as follows:


