WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 02-2022 of the Municipality of Cateel, Davao Oriental, authorizing its CY 2022 General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 02, involving an appropriation of **Nineteen Million Seven Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Pesos & 77/100 (P19,795,870.77)**, was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on August 31, 2022, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160;

It is understood that the projects in the Supplemental AIP are likewise deliberated and favorably endorsed by the Municipal Development Council to Sangguniang Bayan for their approval in a Resolution Form.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to inform the Municipality of Cateel, Davao Oriental, that this review action does not authorize any item of appropriation that is specifically prohibited by or inconsistent with the provisions of law.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to send a copy of this Resolution to the Sangguniang Bayan of Cateel, Davao Oriental, through the Municipal Mayor.
