A RESOLUTION FORWARDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITIES OF LUPON, BOSTON, AND CATEEL, ALL OF THIS PROVINCE, TO THE PROVINCIAL LOCAL FINANCE COMMITTEE, THROUGH THE PROVINCIAL BUDGET OFFICER, FOR TECHNICAL REVIEW AND APPROPRIATE RECOMMENDATION THEREOF, PURSUANT TO SECTION 316(f) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991.

WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 04-2022 of the Municipality of Lupon, Davao Oriental, authorizing its FY 2023 General Fund Annual Budget, involving an appropriation of Four Hundred Forty-Seven Million Seven Hundred Seventy Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-Four Pesos (P447,770,984.00), was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on December 14, 2022, and the same was docketed as Communication No. 17-237-2022:

WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 92, series of 2022, of the Municipality of Boston, Davao Oriental, authorizing its CY 2022 General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 4, involving an appropriation of <u>Seventeen Million Three Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Five Pesos and 10/100 (P17,356,375.10)</u>, was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on December 28, 2022, and the same was docketed as Communication No. 17-248-2022;

WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 93, series of 2022, of the Municipality of Boston, Davao Oriental, authorizing its FY 2023 General Fund Annual Budget, involving an appropriation of <u>One Hundred Seventy Million Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Four Pesos (P170,759,504.00)</u>, was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on December 28, 2022, and the same was docketed as Communication No. 17-249-2022:

WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 06-2022 of the Municipality of Lupon, Davao Oriental, authorizing its CY 2022 Supplemental Budget No. 5, involving an appropriation of <u>Eight Million Seven Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Pesos (P8,794,950.00)</u>, was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on December 28, 2022, and the same was docketed as Communication No. 17-251-2022;

WHEREAS, Appropriation Ordinance No. 04-2022 of the Municipality of Cateel, Davao Oriental, authorizing its FY 2023 General Fund Annual Budget, involving an appropriation of <a href="Two Hundred Sixty-Three Million Six Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Three Pesos (P263,676,353.00)">Two Hundred Sixty-Three Million Six Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Three Pesos (P263,676,353.00)</a>, was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on December 29, 2022, and the same was docketed as Communication No. 17-252-2022;

WHEREAS, Section 327 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides among others that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan shall review the ordinance authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the same manner and within 90 days from receipt of copies of such ordinance;

WHEREAS, the reglementary period of review of the foregoing Appropriation Ordinances will end on March 14, March 28 and March 30, 2023 respectively;

WHEREAS, Section 316(f) of the same Code provides that the Local Finance Committee shall assist the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in the review and evaluation of budget of component cities and municipalities xxx and recommend the appropriate action thereon;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Marietta D. Palmera, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Shella Marie S. Go, Stephen Paul L. Uy, Harold A. Montes, Rotchie M. Ravelo, Daud V. Linsag, and Eleuterio C. Manaytay, it was
