



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5, s. 2023

**CREATING A PROVINCIAL TASK FORCE ON
TAX COLLECTION ENFORCEMENT PLAN
AND ITS TECHNICAL WORK GROUP IN THE
PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL**

WHEREAS, Local Government Units, under R.A. 7160, are tasked to maximize efforts to effectively collect all taxes due the government, more particularly Real Property taxes (Sections 197-283, Chapter 1, Title Two, Book II of LGC), and, other local impositions (Sections 135 to 141, *Art. 1, Chapter 2, Title One of Book II*) thereof.

WHEREAS, recognizing this mandate, it has become necessary to institutionalize the administrative system in the collection of local revenues, of this Unit, to the end that more efficacious strategies may be drawn to effect the transformation of its financial capability into a self-reliant one, in order to be capable of delivering essential services to its constituents and accelerating its development objectives. Hence, there is a need to create a Project Management Team, in coordination with allied national government functionaries, to undertake the administration and implementation of the Tax Collection Enforcement Program of this Unit, based on an intervention scheme adopted by the national government;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **CORAZON T. NUÑEZ-MALANYAON**, Provincial Governor of Davao Oriental, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order that:

SECTION 1. A Provincial Task Force on Tax Collection Enforcement Plan shall be created to be composed of the following officials of this Province and concerned national officials, as follows:

National and local offices, may, through this Order, group themselves, consolidate, or coordinate their efforts, services, and resources for purposes commonly beneficial to them. In support of such undertakings, the offices involved may, contribute funds, resources, manpower, equipment, and other kinds of support and appoint or assign personnel under such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by the participating offices. .

SECTION II. The herein created Task Force shall exercise the hereunder enumerated duties and functions based on the proposed Project Management and Institutional Framework on TCEP, viz:

- a. To organize Task Force on TCEP in the municipalities within the jurisdiction of this Province:
- b. To formulate and implement the Tax Collection Enforcement Plan:
- c. To monitor and evaluate TCEP activities in the Province;
- d. To organize and conduct training programs, and
- e. To submit for review to the Regional Task Force on TCEP, the Provincial TCEP Plan.

SECTION III. **Secretariat.** To provide technical supervision and management of the Plan, a Work Group under this Task Force, is likewise created, to be composed of technical staff from the offices of the above-mentioned officials, which will act as Secretariat with PDTF/Finance Committee, to avoid duplication and overlapping of activities, and smoothly achieve the purpose of this Order. The main functions of the secretariat are:

- a. To make arrangements for meetings of the municipal treasurers, assessors and other concerned local and national offices;
- b. To monitor and assist implementation of the commitments under this Executive Order through collection, analysis and review of information and data provided by Parties;
- c. To maintain records, data, and official documents, of the Program under the collection schemes.
- d. To coordinate with other implementing agencies and other involved agencies;

All other departments, bureaus, offices, agencies and instrumentalities, including government-owned or controlled corporations within the jurisdiction of this Province, are hereby

directed to extend assistance to the herein created Task Force in the prompt accomplishment of its responsibilities.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
