WHEREAS, the Davao Oriental Provincial Medical Center (DOPMC) in the City of Mati is the lone secondary hospital in the Province of Davao Oriental catering the total population in the province and nearby municipalities from other provinces as its catchment areas;

WHEREAS, DOPMC is also the apex hospital in the province receiving patient referrals from primary care facilities, safe birthing facilities, and other infirmaries within the provider care network;

WHEREAS, bed occupancy status of DOPMC is always over and beyond authorized bed capacity which is also affected by limited personnel. Hence, standard healthcare worker-to-patient ratio was never achieved;

WHEREAS, re-nationalization of DOPMC is deemed needed to increase bed capacity budget allocation and upgrade laboratory equipment and medical supplies, specialized services and proficient medical professionals;
