A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE OUTSTANDING ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF LIEUTENANT COLONEL ENRIQUE G RAFAEL O-129945 INFANTRY (GENERAL STAFF CORPS) PHILIPPINE ARMY, FOR HIS MERITORIOUS AND INVALUABLE SERVICES RENDERED AS COMMANDER OF 48TH INFANTRY (GUARDIANS) BATTALION, 7TH INFANTRY DIVISION, PHILIPPINE ARMY, 02 February 2021 to 31 January 2023.

WHEREAS, imbued with high degree of professionalism in the performance of major responsibility, LIEUTENANT COLONEL RAFAEL efficiently led the Battalion in the successful conduct of Focused Military Operations in the Provinces of Surigao del Sur and Agusan del Sur; Municipalities of Pantukan and Mabini, in Davao de Oro; and Lupon, Banaybanay, San Isidro and Governor Generoso, in Davao Oriental. On operations, LIEUTENANT COLONEL RAFAEL led the unit in one (1) Division Operation, seven (7) Brigade Operations and 16 Battalion-sized Operations. Likewise, he closely supervised 16 Company Operations, 24 Platoon-sized Operations and 3,546 Small Unit Operations that complemented the implementation of three (3) sustainment of

Community Support Programs which successfully conducted in the Municipalities of Mabini and Pantukan, all of Davao de Oro; Provinces of Surigao del Sur and Agusan del Sur and various deployment of Battalion Sustainment Teams (BSTs) and Forward Observation Detachment (FOD) in the Provinces of Davao de Oro and Davao Oriental as conflict-resilient communities; dismantling of WGF18, SRC2, SMRC; WGF2, WGF3, ROC, RHQ, SRGU, and SMRC which contributed to the declaration of insurgency free in the Provinces of Davao de Oro and Davao Oriental;

WHEREAS, on Law Enforcement Support Operations, he effectively implemented Critical Infrastructure and Investment Protection Security Operations (CIIPSO) to existing vital installations and one (1) construction company that implements flagship and developmental projects in the unit's area of operation. Likewise, he strongly supported the Anti-Illegal Logging Campaign of DENR which resulted to the confiscation of more or less 10,000 board feet of illegally cut lumbers. He closely supervised the conduct of humanitarian assistance and disaster response;

WHEREAS, on Intelligence, LIEUTENANT COLONEL RAFAEL ably provided direction for the enhancement of intelligence capability and empowered the intelligence platoon;

WHEREAS, on Civil-Military Operations, LIEUTENANT COLONEL RAFAEL emphasized on serving the people particularly the Indigenous People and Peoples Organization to alleviate their plight. He provided livelihood programs and trainings and in availing the basic services from different government and non-government organizations;

WHEREAS, his leadership acumen in TRIAD Operations remarkably contributed to the sustained and improved internal stability and development which is now being enjoyed by the people in the area of operations;

WHEREAS, on training, LIEUTENANT COLONEL RAFAEL ensured two (2) Platoon Sustainment Trainings (PST), two (2) Squad Sustainment Trainings (SST) and 26 In-House Training Programs including one (1) Organic Agriculture Production NCII Skills Training were properly conducted by TESDA XI, thus maintained the unit's and personnel's high level of preparedness both in combat and non-combat operations;

WHEREAS, by these enormous and laudable achievements, LIEUTENANT COLONEL RAFAEL earned lasting credit and honor not only for himself and his unit but also for the 7th Infantry (Kaugnay) Division and the Philippine Army as well;




