A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LUPON, DAVAO ORIENTAL, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND OTHER PLACES AND SPACES CONSIDERED AS HIGH RISK TO INSTALL VIDEO SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS OR CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES", CONSIDERING THAT THE SAME IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lupon, Davao Oriental, submitted Municipal Ordinance No. 2023-01 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for an appropriate legislative action;

WHEREAS, as recommended by law enforcement agencies that Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) System is among the most effective tools in crime deterrence, prevention, detection, and solution, an ordinance to require the use of CCTV Systems in business establishments within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Lupon, Province of Davao Oriental is deemed proper;
