WHEREAS, presented for consideration before the August Body is an urgent request of the Honorable Governor Corazon N. Malanyaon, thru her letter, dated March 13, 2023, addressed to the Honorable Members of the 17<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlalawigan thru the Vice Governor, Honorable Niño Sotero L. Uy, Jr., for the passage of a resolution authorizing her for the aforementioned subject matter, docketed as Communication No. 17-353-2023:

WHEREAS, fully aware of the constitutional mandate to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them, the Provincial Government of Davao Oriental shall establish a Blood Sufficiency and Safety Program
