AN ORDINANCE REVERTING TO THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCES OF THE CY 2023 GENERAL FUND THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR SAVINGS FROM SALARIES AND OTHER COMPENSATIONS OF VARIOUS OFFICES, OTHER LOCALLY FUNDED PPAs, 20% LOCAL GOVERNMENT DEVELOPMENT FUNDS (LGDF) – CY 2023 CURRENT APPROPRIATIONS, AND REALIGNING THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR LOANS AND BORROWINGS UNDER THE LAND BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (LBP) AND DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (DBP); AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING ITS CORRESPONDING APPROPRIATIONS TO FUND VARIOUS PRIORITY PROGRAMS/PROJECTS/ACTIVITIES OF THIS PROVINCE.

WHEREAS, there are programs/projects/activities of the Provincial Government which aims at strengthening institutional capacity in delivering infrastructure, tourism, and social services projects, as well as the implementation of relevant projects and various activities in support to the government’s program that require funding;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Accountant and Provincial Treasurer have certified as to the availability of funds needed for the implementation of the identified priority

programs/projects/activities, and will be taken from the reversion of savings from salaries and other compensations of various offices, and other locally funded PPAs, 20% LGDF – CY 2023 Current Appropriations, and realignment of appropriations for loans and borrowings under the Land Bank of the Philippines and Development Bank of the Philippines;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Marietta D. Palmera, unanimously seconded by all the Members present, it was

Be it ordained by the 17th Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Davao Oriental, by virtue of the powers vested in it by law, in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. REVERSION - It is hereby approved the reversions to the CY 2023 Unappropriated balances of the General Fund Annual Budget of the Provincial Government of Davao Oriental the appropriations for the savings from salaries and other compensations of various offices, and other locally funded PPAs, 20% LGDF – CY 2023 Current Appropriations in the amount of **₱80,247,450.09**, to wit: (*Summary only, table to be inserted in the final format*)

- Salary savings of various offices/departments in the amount of **P 22,700,989.09**
- 20% LGDF – 2023 Current Appropriation (Debt Service Loan Amortization) in the amount of **P 55,311,461.00**
- Other Locally Funded PPAs in the amount of **P 2,235,000.00**

SECTION 2. REALIGNMENT OF APPROPRIATION FOR LOANS AND BORROWINGS (APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 16-19-05-2022) - It is hereby approved the realignment of funds for the approved projects under the loan and borrowings with the Land Bank of the Philippines and Development Bank of the Philippines in the amount of **₱687,000,000.00**, to wit:

- Funds under the Land Bank of the Philippines in the amount of **P 371,000,000.00**
- Funds under the Development Bank of the Philippines in the amount of **P 316,000,000.00**

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY- This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.



