AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ABOLITION AND CREATION OF VARIOUS PLANTILLA POSITIONS UNDER THE DIFFERENT OFFICES OF THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL.

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive has requested the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to pass an ordinance abolishing and creating various plantilla positions under the Provincial Government Office, this province;

WHEREAS, the said actions are deemed necessary to ensure that all positions remain relevant, functional, and appropriately attuned to the current dynamics, as well as to elevate the productivity, effectiveness, and efficiency of public service delivery;

WHEREAS, Section 76 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirement and financial capability, subject to the minimum standard and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission;

Be it ordained by the 17th Sangguniang Panlalawaigan of Davao Oriental, by virtue of the powers vested in it by law, in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. ABOLITION OF POSITIONS - the following positions are hereby approved for abolition:

A. Provincial Tourism Office

- One (1) Nutrition Officer I Item No. 19 - SG 10

B. Davao Oriental Provincial Medical Center

- Two (2) Administrative Asst. IV (Cash Clerk II) Item Nos. 77 and 78 - SG 6

C. Provincial Veterinarian's Office

- One (1) Administrative Aide VI (Comp. Optr.) Item No. 3 - SG 7

D. Provincial Population Office

- One (1) Population Prog. Worker II Item No. 6 - SG 7

Funding of the abolished positions shall be reverted to Unappropriated Balances of the CY 2023 General Fund of this province.

SECTION 2. CREATION OF POSITIONS - the following positions are hereby approved for creation:

A. Provincial Tourism Office

- One (1) Administrative Assistant IV (Bookbinder IV) SG 10

B. Davao Oriental Provincial Medical Center

- One (1) Administrative Assistant IV (Bookbinder IV) SG 10
➤ One (1) Administrative Aide I SG 1

C. Provincial Veterinarian's Office

- One (1) Administrative Assistant IV (Bookbinder IV) SG 10

D. Provincial Population Office

- One (1) Administrative Aide I SG 1

Funding of the newly created positions shall be included in the CY 2023 General Fund of this Province.

SECTION 3. IMPLEMENTATION – the implementation and execution of this Ordinance shall be subject to the existing and applicable Civil Service Laws, Rules and Regulations and shall be in accordance with relevant budget circulars of the Department of Budget and Management and other pertinent laws thereof.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE - all existing measures with a provision or provisions which are inconsistent with this ordinance, the same are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - Should any provision of this Ordinance is found invalid and declared unconstitutional, the rest of the provisions not otherwise affected shall remain effective and enforceable.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY – this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval hereof.




