A RESOLUTION INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION ON THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF CARAGA A1, A2, AND A3 MINI HYDROPOWER PLANT PROJECTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CARAGA, THIS PROVINCE.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Governor Corazon N. Malanyaon submitted before the August Body proposal of the Volga Power Corporation as well as their request for an SP Resolution interposing no objection to the aforementioned proposed projects;

WHEREAS, the Volga Power Corporation is a sister company of Markham Resources Corporation (MRC), a Philippine-based private holding company founded in 2014, which focuses on investments, financing, constructing, managing, and maintaining power generation facilities that provide reliable and cost effective energy solutions:

WHEREAS, the Department of Energy awarded Service Contracts for the Caraga A1, Caraga A2, and Caraga A3 hydropower projects to Volga on November 22. 2016, which makes the Caraga A1, A2, and A3 Hydro Power Corporations all subsidiaries of MRC;
