A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE GOVERNOR CORAZON N. MALANYAON, FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF DAVAO ORIENTAL, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE CITY LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF MATI, REPRESENTED BY ITS CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MICHELLE N. RABAT, RELATIVE TO THE BALAY SILANGAN OPERATIONALIZATION PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the First Party in its reconstitution of the City Anti-Drug Abuse Council hereby mandated to appropriate substantial amount of funds from their annual budget to be utilized in assisting the enforcement of RA 9165, giving priority to rehabilitation and treatment to drug dependents, drug users and drug surrenderees pursuant to Joint Memorandum of DILG and DDB Circular No. 2018-01, series of 2018;

WHEREAS, the City of Mati has been providing financial assistance to drug dependents seeking interventions to Treatment and Rehabilitation Facilities;

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement is necessary to ensure a more effective and efficient system of implementation of the financial assistance to drug dependents referred to Balay Silangan for treatment and rehabilitation;

WHEREAS, Chapter III, Section 465(b)(1)(vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991, states that the Provincial Governor, as the chief executive of the provincial government, shall “*represent the province in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the sangguniang panlalawigan or pursuant to law or ordinance*”;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Art Benjie C. Bulaong, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Harold A. Montes, Rotchie M. Ravelo, Stephen Paul L. Uy, Daud V. Linsag, and Anna Cheryl N. Castro, it was


