EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 12

AN ORDER CREATING THE PLANNING TEAM CORE GROUP AND ITS TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP, FOR THE UPDATING OF THE PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT AND PHYSICAL FRAMEWORK PLAN (PDPFP) OF DAVAO ORIENTAL

WHEREAS, Section 20(c) of the Local Government Code mandates LGUs to prepare their respective comprehensive land use plans (Physical Framework Plan in case of provinces) which shall be the primary and dominant bases for the future use of land resources, and that the requirements for food production, human settlements, and industrial expansion shall be taken into consideration in the preparation of such plans. Sections 106 and 109 of the Code likewise mandate the LGUs to prepare comprehensive multisectoral development plans and public investment programs;

WHEREAS, DILG-NEDA-DEM-DOF JMC No. 1 Series of 2016 prescribed the Synchroized Planning and Budgeting Calendar 2016 Edition that outline the updating of planning databases and the preparation or updating of plans every election year;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11201 created the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) that is mandated to formulate and prescribe land use planning guidelines for the formulation of the Provincial Physical Framework Plans (PPFPs), Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plans (PDPFPs) of provinces. Section 12 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 11201 vested the authority to the Secretary of the department to ratify the PDPFP of the provinces;

WHEREAS, DHSUD MC No. 2021 which provides the review, adoption and approval process for Provincial Physical Framework Plans (PPFPs)/Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plans (PDPFPs);

WHEREAS, the existing 2017-2022 PDPFP of Davao Oriental is already due for updating for another plan period;

WHEREAS, the preparation of the PDPFP requires a planning team that will back up the Provincial Development Council in the various preparatory, consultative and technical activities in order to come with a good quality and acceptable updated PDPFP;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Corazon N. Malanyaon, Provincial Governor, Province of Davao Oriental by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order to create the Planning Team Core Group (PTCG) and its Technical Working Group (TWG) for the updating of the Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plan (PDPFP) of Davao Oriental.

Other pertinent bodies/agency/entities may be invited by the committee on a case-to-case basis for a specific purpose.

SECTION 2 – FUNCTIONS

The functions of the committee shall include but not limited to the following:

1. Responsible for coordinating all technical and administrative activities in the updating of the PDPPF including stakeholder consultations/meetings/conferences/workshops;
2. Coordinate the planning activities, draft and consolidate the contents of the updated PDPPF document;
3. Facilitate the presentation of the draft updated PDPPF to the DHSUD/PLUC and endorsement to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

SECTION 3 – TECHNICAL WORKING GROUPS COMPOSITIONS:

There shall be technical working group for each of the five development sectors of the local development plan namely, social development, economic development, physical/land use development, environmental management, and institutional development. The technical working groups shall be composed of the representatives of the following offices/sectors, respectively:

2. Conduct of surveys, consultations/ meetings, workshops;
3. Integration/ finalization of studies, research findings, and consultation survey outputs;

SECTION 5 – TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT

The Provincial Planning and Development Office (PPDO) shall provide technical and administrative support in all activities in the updating of the PDPFP.

SECTION 6 – PLANNING TIMELINE AND MILESTONE

The updating of the PDPFP shall observe the timeline and milestone set in the Synchronized Local Budgeting and Planning Calendar (SLBPC) 2016 Edition. The conduct of activities for planning shall be in accordance with the guidelines as provided in DILG-NULIA-DBM-DOF JMC No. 1 Series of 2016 and in DHSUD MC No. 2021-009, Series of 2021;

SECTION 7 – REPEALING CAUSE

All Executive Order, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any provision of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 8 – EFFECTIVITY

The PDPFP Planning Team Core Group and Technical Working Group shall exercise their functions and duties effective immediately and until the PDPFP preparation is completed and ratified at the national level.
