EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 1, SERIES OF 2021

**AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (PRODRMC) AND DESIGNATING ITS MEMBERS AND OFFICERS**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Constitution and House of Representatives Act No. 10121 of 2010 known as the "Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010";

WHEREAS, Article 2 of R.A. 10121 states that it is the policy of the government to protect the rights of the Filipino people by addressing and reducing disaster risks, strengthening the nation's resilience to disasters, and disaster management, and seeking the solution of disaster-related issues through a participatory approach;

WHEREAS, Article 5 of the aforementioned Order and Regulation of the Department of the Interior and Local Government provides that the organization of a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council shall be at the local government level;

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to adopt a disaster risk reduction approach that is comprehensive, integrated, and proactive in addressing the social and environmental aspects of disasters including climate change and disaster preparedness, the involvement and participation of all State, Local Government, private sector, volunteers, all stakeholders concerned, and the community;

WHEREAS, there is a need to constitute and update the membership of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council of this Province to the vision, mission, and objectives of the council;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GONZALES MARIANO MALANAYAN, Governor of this Province, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (PRODRMC) as follows:

**SECTION 1. COMPOSITION.** The membership of the PRODRMC shall be as follows:

*Foregoing representations from the CSOs are on hold over capacity from the previous PDRRMC, to avoid hiatus in the private sector representations, provided, that said representations may be updated when the selection process as prescribed by DILG MC No. 2016-97 shall have been undertaken.*

**SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF PDRRMC** – As provided under Section 11 (b) of RA 10121 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, the following are the functions of the Council:

- 2.1 Approve, monitor, and evaluate the implementation of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (PDRRMP) and annually review, test, and develop the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
- 2.2 Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs, budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
- 2.3 Recommend the implementation of Pre-Emptive and Forced evacuation of local residents, if necessary;
- 2.4 Convene the local council once every three (3) months or as often as necessary;
- 2.5 Perform such other functions that are incidental to and are necessary for the performance of disaster risk reduction and management;
- 2.6 The Provincial DRRM Officer shall serve as the PDRRMC Secretary; and
- 2.7 All PDRRMC member agencies shall assign and designate their permanent DRRM Focal Person.

**SECTION 3. CREATION OF FOUR (4) THEMATIC AREA CLUSTERS** – There shall be created four (4) Thematic Area Clusters under the PDRRMC and shall be headed by the following:

Thematic Clusters	Vice Chairperson
3.1 Disaster Prevention and Mitigation –	Provincial Env't & Natural Resource Officer
3.2 Disaster Preparedness –	Provincial DRRM Officer
3.3 Disaster Response –	Provincial Social Welfare & Dev't Officer
3.4 Disaster Rehabilitation & Recovery –	Provincial Planning & Development Officer

The change made shall be deemed to have been made by the signatories to the original agreement.

**SECTION 4. OTHER AGREEMENTS AND CONTRACTS**  
Respective Board/Committee shall have the authority to enter into

- 1. All subject matter of the agreement shall be deemed to be a part of the agreement.
- 2. Provide herein as to the nature and extent of the agreement.
- 3. Deal with each other in good faith and with candor and honesty.
- 4. Represent and warrant to each other that they are not in breach of any other agreement.

**SECTION 5. ENTIRE AGREEMENT CLAUSE - All other agreements made by the parties hereto shall be deemed to be null and void.**

**SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision of this agreement is held to be unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.**

**SECTION 7. DISSENTS.** This agreement shall be deemed to be in full force and effect only if signed by all parties hereto.
