A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 573, SERIES OF 2023, OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION VI, NUMBER 13 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 491, SERIES OF 2022, KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTING THE PROMOTION OF HALAL INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM OF THE CITY OF MATI, CREATING A LOCAL HALAL COUNCIL, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES", CONSIDERING THAT THE SAME IS WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD PURSUANT TO ARTICLE III, SECTION 458(a)(1) OF REPUBLIC ACT 7160.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that: "Every Local Government Unit (LGU) shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare xxx";

WHEREAS, presented for review before the August Body is City Ordinance No. 573, series of 2023, forwarded by Mr. Juvy L. Mabini, Secretary to the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mati, Davao Oriental, docketed as Communication No. 17-660-2023;

WHEREAS, as part of its legislative functions defined in Article III, Section 458(a)(1) of Republic Act 7160, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mati, Davao Oriental, passed and approved the aforementioned ordinance to respectively amend the composition of Halal Council by replacing KONSUMO MATI as member of the HALAL COUNCIL to Philippine Chamber of Commerce & Industry (PCCI), Davao Oriental Chamber of Commerce & Industry, represented by Engr. Rufo C. Trocio as their new representative;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Daud V. Linsag, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Rotchie M. Ravelo, Anna Cheryl N. Castro, Marietta D. Palmera, Andy A. Monday, Stephen Paul L. Uy, and Harold A. Montes, it was
