A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-09 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LUPON, DAVAO ORIENTAL, ENTITLED: “AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MIGRANTS ADVISORY AND INFORMATION NETWORK (MAIN) DESK IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LUPON, DAVAO ORIENTAL”, CONSIDERING THAT THE SAME IS WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE III, SECTION 447(a)(1) OF REPUBLIC ACT 7160.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act 9208, otherwise known as the “**Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003**” provides that: *“the State values the dignity of every human person and guarantees the respect of individual rights. In pursuit of this policy, the State shall give highest priority to the enactment of measures and development of programs that will promote human dignity, protect the people from any threat of violence and exploitation, eliminate trafficking in persons, and mitigate pressures for involuntary migration and servitude of persons, not only to support trafficked persons but more importantly, to ensure their recovery, rehabilitation and reintegration into the mainstream of society”;*

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government, mandates the Local Government Units (LGU) to establish a **Migrants Advisory Information Network (MAIN) Desks** within the Women and Children's Desks or any existing or other equivalent mechanism, as defined in its Memorandum Circular No. 2005-26, dated March 14, 2005, to sustain the campaign against trafficking in person and to ensure a unified and synchronized effort in preventing and eliminating human trafficking pursuant to Republic Act No. 9208;

WHEREAS, in adherence to the above cited provisions and in compliance to the foregoing DILG Memorandum Circular 2005-26, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lupon, this Province, enacted the aforementioned ordinance on the 9th day of October, 2023 which was submitted for legislative review before the August Body, docketed as Communication No. 17-677-2023;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Daud V. Linsag, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Harold A. Montes and Stephen Paul L. Uy, it was

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, **CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-09 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LUPON, DAVAO ORIENTAL, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MIGRANTS ADVISORY AND INFORMATION NETWORK (MAIN) DESK IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LUPON, DAVAO ORIENTAL"**, CONSIDERING THAT THE SAME IS WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE III, SECTION 447(a)(1) OF REPUBLIC ACT 7160;


