RABAT, CITY MAYOR OF MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL, RE: "GUIDELINES ON THE ALLOWABLE USES OF MUNICIPAL WATERS FRONTING DAHICAN BEACH IN MAYO BAY PARTICULARLY, FROM SITIO CADANLA-AN (6° 55'51.57" N, 126°17'12.28" E) TO SITIO SANDIGAN (6°55'13.66N, 126° 16'55.46" E)", CONSIDERING THAT ALL ARE WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED POWERS OF THE CITY MAYOR PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 1, SECTION 455 (b)(2)(iii) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 OR RA 7160.
