A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO SEVERE DAMAGES AND EXTENSIVE DESTRUCTION CAUSED BY HEAVY RAINFALL DUE TO SHEARLINE ON JANUARY 16, 2024.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, specifically Section 2 of Rule 12 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations thereof, provides that the local sanggunian, upon the recommendation of the local DRRMC, may issue the declaration of state of calamity based on the results of the damage assessment and needs analysis;

WHEREAS, the heavy rainfall due to shearline, which is the convergence of the cold northeast monsoon and warm winds blowing from the Pacific Ocean, affected the entire province last January 16, 2024. It brought massive flooding and landslides incidents in some parts of the province which has affected road networks, school buildings, resettlements, water supply, electricity, agriculture, livelihood among others;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council Emergency Operation Center (PRDRMC-EOC) has reported data (partial/progress)

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based from the recently consolidated situational reports from the eleven (11) local government units and Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) results. Conducted last January 21-22, 2024, the damages and effects are as follows:

- a. 64,330 families affected with 2 deaths and 4 injuries
- b. Damages from agriculture, livestock and livelihood valued at P113,188,506.83
- c. Damages to road networks and critical infrastructure hindered the government's emergency response and disrupted the provision of basic services to the communities;

WHEREAS, the Municipalities of Tarragona, Caraga and Lupon have already declared their respective area of jurisdiction under the State of Calamity. With this, the authority to declare the State of Calamity is in conformity to Section 4.a.iii of the NDRRMC Memorandum Order No. 60, series of 2019, dated June 17, 2019, which provides that "when two or more municipalities or cities are affected by disaster, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, upon the recommendation of the Provincial DRRM Council, may declare the entire province under a State of Calamity;

WHEREAS, the declaration under a State of Calamity would take expedient measures from both the national and local governments thereby mitigating the effects of the disaster most specially the affected constituents of the Province of Davao Oriental;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Harold A. Montes, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Stephen Paul L. Uy, Eleuterio C. Manaytay, Rotchie M. Ravelo, Anna Cheryl N. Castro, Andy A. Monday, Marietta D. Palmera, Art Benjie C. Bulaong, and Shanine C. Lintogonan, it was

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, **DECLARING THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO SEVERE DAMAGES AND EXTENSIVE DESTRUCTION CAUSED BY HEAVY RAINFALL DUE TO SHEARLINE ON JANUARY 16, 2024;**
