A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 576, SERIES OF 2023, OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL, ENTITLED: “AN ORDINANCE DECLARING LUBAN ISLAND AND ITS MARINE ENVIRONS AS LOCAL CONSERVATION AREA AND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”, CONSIDERING THAT THE SAME IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW.

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Section 2(a) of Republic Act 9147, otherwise known as “Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act” explicitly provides its objective to conserve and protect wildlife species and their habitats to promote ecological balance and enhance biological diversity;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 458(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”, the Sangguniang Panlungsod has the power and duty to enact ordinances to *protect the environment and impose appropriate penalties for acts which endanger the environment, such as dynamite fishing and other forms of destructive fishing, illegal logging and smuggling of logs, smuggling of natural resources products and of endangered species of flora and fauna, slash and burn farming, and such other activities which result in pollution, acceleration of eutrophication*

of rivers and lakes or of ecological imbalance;

WHEREAS, Section 468(1)(i) of RA 7160, provides the power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to review all ordinances approved by the Sanggunian of the component City to determine whether these are within the scope of the prescribed powers of the Sangguniang Panglungsod;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Eleuterio C. Manaytay, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Andy A. Monday, Marietta D. Palmera, Stephen Paul L. Uy, Harold A. Montes, Joselito B. Villademos, and Shanine C. Lintogonan, it was


