A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE GOVERNOR NIÑO SOTERO L. UY, JR., FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF DAVAO ORIENTAL, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION (MOC) AMONG OTHER STAKEHOLDERS TO FORM THE CORRIDOR ALLIANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE (CAAC) IN THE EASTERN MINDANAO BIODIVERSITY CORRIDOR, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INTEGRATED APPROACH IN THE MANAGEMENT OF MAJOR BIODIVERSITY CORRIDOR IN THE PHILIPPINES (BD CORRIDOR PROJECT) FUNDED BY THE GLOBAL ENVIRONMENT FACILITY - UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (GEF-UNDP).

WHEREAS, the primary objective of BD Corridor project is to operationalize the integrated management of biodiversity corridors to generate multiple benefits, including

effective conservation of globally threatened species and high conservation value forests, reduce deforestation and degradation, and enhance local biodiversity-friendly livelihoods;

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Cooperation (MoC) establishes a framework for collaboration among the stakeholders to form the Corridor Alliance Advisory Committee (CAAC) in the Eastern Mindanao Biodiversity Corridor which will serve as a platform for dialogue, coordination, and cooperation in the implementation of the "Integrated Approach in the Management of Major Biodiversity Corridors in the Philippines (BD Corridor Project) funded by the Global Environment Facility – United Nations Development Programme (GEF-UNDP);

WHEREAS, Chapter III, Section 465(b)(1)(vi) of RA 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991, states that: "the Provincial Governor, as the Chief Executive of the Provincial Government, shall represent the province in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the sangguniang panlalawigan or pursuant to law or ordinance";

**WHEREFORE,** on motion of SP Member Eleuterio C. Manaytay, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Stephen Paul L. Uy, Michelle M. Centeno, Marietta D. Palmera, and Daud V. Linsag, it was
