A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LUPON, DAVAO ORIENTAL, ENTITLED: “AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND STRENGTHENING THE OFFICE FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS (OSCA) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LUPON, DAVAO ORIENTAL, AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”, SUBJECT TO THE EXISTING IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT 9994 AND DILG MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2017-18, DATED FEBRUARY 2, 2017.

WHEREAS, Rule VI, Article 21 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9994, otherwise known as the “*EXPANDED SENIOR CITIZENS ACT*”

OF 2010”, provides that: “There shall be established in all cities and municipalities an Office for Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA)”;

WHEREAS, presented for review before the August Body is Municipal Ordinance No. 2024-01 of the Municipality of Lupon, this province, submitted by its Sangguniang Bayan Secretary Ms. Fatima L. Malaluan, docketed as Communication No. 17-848-2024;

WHEREAS, the said ordinance was enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lupon, on the 12th day of February, 2024, in adherence to the above cited provisions. Nonetheless, the Committee favorably recommends to the concerned sanggunian that Section 5 thereof, conforms to the pertinent provisions stipulated in Rule VI, Article 21, Section 1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9994, considering that the two qualifications under items **f.) Good moral character** and **g.) At least a high school graduate**, were not included;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Daud V. Linsag, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Harold A. Montes, Anna Cheryl N. Castro, and Shella Marie S. Go, it was


