**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 06-17-2023 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO, DAVAO ORIENTAL, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY, SUBJECT TO SOME CONDITIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, Appropriation Ordinance No. 06-17-2023 of the Municipality of San Isidro, Davao Oriental, authorizing its CY 2024 General Fund Annual Budget involving an appropriation of ONE HUNDRED NINETY MILLION NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE PESOS (₱190,097,571.00), was submitted to this Sanggunian for review on December 27, 2023, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160;

**WHEREAS**, the subject Appropriation Ordinance shows substantial compliance with the same law and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

**WHEREFORE**, on motion of SP Member Andy A. Monday, duly and jointly seconded by SP Members Shanine C. Lintogonan, Anna Cheryl N. Castro, Eleuterio C. Manaytay, and Michelle M. Centeno, it was

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED:

**RESOLVED**, to declare Appropriation Ordinance No. 06-17-2023 of the Municipality of San Isidro, Davao Oriental, **OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY** as of its stated effectivity date, subject to the posting requirements under Section 59 of RA No. 7160, and subject further to the following conditions:

1. The LGU is advised to make necessary adjustment by way of reducing the appropriation by P69,290.00 since the reduction of NTA would affect the implementation of PPAs identified under 20% DF, 5% CF, and possibly on other items;
2. Utilization of the appropriations for the PPAs funded in this budget shall be in accordance with the approved CY 2024 Annual Investment (AIP) and/or Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) Development Plan pursuant to Sections 287 and 305(i) of RA 7160; DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2004-130, dated October 1, 20024; DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF JMC No. 1, s. 2016, dated November 18, 2016.
3. Utilization of LDRRM Fund shall conform with Section 21 of RA 10121 and Rule 18, Section 1 of its IRR;
4. Utilization of 20% Development Fund implementing its PPAs shall be in accordance with DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, dated November 4, 2022;
5. Implementation of PPAs to address the problem of Illegal Drugs shall conform with Section 51 of RA No. 9165 and its IRR;
6. The utilization of Confidential Fund shall be in accordance with DBM-DILG-DND-GCG-COA Joint Circular No. 2015-01, dated January 8, 2015. Likewise, PPAs under the Peace & Order shall be in accordance with DILG MC No. 2015-128, dated November 2, 2015, and other relevant policies and budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
7. The grant of Terminal Leave Benefits and Monetization of Leave Credits shall be in accordance with CSC Omnibus Rules on Leave pursuant to CSC MC No. 41, s. 1998; Budget Circular No. 2013-1, dated April 12, 2013; and Budget Circular No. 2016-2, dated March 29, 2016;
8. Payment of Magna Carta Benefits to Public Health Workers shall be consistent with the rules and regulations prescribed under DBM-DOH Joint Circular No. 1, s. 2012, dated November 29, 2012 as amended by DBM-DOH Joint Circular No. 1, s. 2016, dated January 15, 2016;
9. Annual Operating Budget of Local Economic Enterprise (LEE) shall be in accordance with Sections 313(a) and 325 of the Local Government Code.

**MOREOVER**, the LGU is herein reminded of the provisions of Section 56 in relation with Sections 325 and 327 of the Local Government Code, which provides that within three (3) days after the approval of the Ordinance authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations, the secretary to the Sanggunian shall forward the said Ordinance to the appropriate reviewing authority.

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, to send a copy of this Resolution to the Sangguniang Bayan of San Isidro, Davao Oriental, through the Municipal Mayor.


