WHEREAS, Chapter 3, Section 465(b)(1)(vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991, states that: "*the Provincial Governor, as the Chief Executive of the Provincial Government, shall represent the province in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the sangguniang panlalawigan or pursuant to law or ordinance*";
