EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RE-CONSTITUTING THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL FOR
THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (PCPC) IN DAVAO ORIENTAL**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7610 (Special Protection of Children Against Child Abuse, Exploitation and Discrimination Act) provide for strong deterrence and special protection against child abuse, exploitation and discrimination and its corresponding penalties;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 386 (The Civic Code of the Philippines) provides that the government shall establish Council for the Protection of Children likewise, Republic Act 87 of PD 603 (The Child and Youth Welfare Code) states that every barangay council shall encourage the organization of a Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) and shall coordinate with the Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) in drawing and implementing plans for safeguarding the rights and securing the welfare of the Filipino child in the 21st century.

WHEREAS, The Third National Plan of Action for Children (3rd NPAC) for 2022-2025 sets the agenda towards the progress realization of the rights of Filipino children and the fulfilment of the commitment of the Government of the Philippines to the United Nation Convention of the Rights of the Child and the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs). It is consistent with the goals, targets and strategies of the Philippine Development Plan, 2019-2022, to articulate the special and specific concern of children.

NOW THEREFORE, I NIÑO SOTERO L. UY, JR., by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION I – CREATION – There is hereby creation a Provincial Council for the Protection of Children (PCPC) in the province.

SECTION 2 – COMPOSITION – The Council shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 3 - ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A.) The Council performs the following functions:

- Formulate policy and legal framework for the Philippine Development Plan for Children, 2023-2025, for progressive realization of children's rights and child stage of development.
- Prepared the 3rd National Plan of Action for Children (NPAC) achieving the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs).
- Recommend local legislation promotion the Philippine Development Plan for 2023-2025 and the local plan of action of provincial thrusts and direction for children.
- Provide technical assistance to the City/Municipality and Barangay Council for the Protection of children.
- Conduct capacity building to enhance knowledge and skills in handling children program.
- Monitor and evaluate the performance implemented of the 3rd NPAC
- Perform such other function provided from other child related laws.

B.) The Child Protection Technical Working Group shall:

- Serve as the central coordinating body of all child protection activities in Davao Oriental.
- Provide strategic direction and leadership.
- Ensure that child protection is regarded as priority concern in times of emergencies.
- Closely coordinate with Regional Child Protection Working Group (RCPWG) to provide assistance in the region.

C.) The Early Childhood Care & Development Coordinating Committee shall:

- Formulate plans, programs & policies for children that are gender-fair, culturally relevant & responsive to the needs of diverse group of children from 0 to below 18 years of age;
- Establish and maintain database on children in the province;
- Provide coordinating linkages with other agencies and institutions in the planning, monitoring and evaluation of plans for children;
- Provide technical assistance & recommend financial support to the City/Municipal and Barangay Council for the Protection of Children;
- Conduct capability building programs to enhance knowledge and skills in handling children's program.

D.) Provincial Inter-agency Monitoring Task Force:

- Gather, collect and organize the required documents,
- Review and validate the consolidated reports of the C/M IMTF on the functionality of BCPC;

- Evaluate the C/MCPC based on submitted documents using LCPC Assessment Form 001-B,
- Confer with concerned City or Municipal Mayors on the outcome of the evaluation and come up with recommended action points; and
- Using LCPC Consolidated Form 001-A and LCPC Consolidated Form 001-8, submit report in soft and hard copies to the DILG Regional Office on or before March 30, copy furnished the DILG Provincial Office.

E.) Specifically, the LCPC Secretariat shall perform the following functions:

- Coordinate with LCPC members;
- Prepare agenda for the LCPC;
- Prepare minutes of the LCPC meeting;
- Follow-through action points and agreements from the LCPC meetings;
- Consolidate AWWPs of various departments related to LCPC plans (provinces, cities, and municipalities);
- Maintain and update relevant data/information/document of the Council;
- Prepare accomplishment report of the LCPC; and
- Monitor services and programs related to LCPC.

SECTION 4 – SECRETARIAT – The Secretariat shall be handled by the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office. They shall be responsible for the documentation of proceedings of meeting, preparation of reports and other necessary documents needed by the council.

SECTION 5 – FUNDING – The Provincial Government shall provide funds for the operation of the council under 1% NTA LCPC.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVITY – The order shall take effect immediately. All previous issuance inconsistent herewith are modified accordingly.
