**AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION
AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (PDRRMC)**

WHEREAS, Section 2 (a) of RA 10121 states that it is the policy of the state to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the cause of vulnerabilities to disasters, strengthening the country's institutional capacity for disaster risk reduction and management, and building the resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of RA 10121 mandates the creation of Provincial, City, and Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils at the local level, providing its minimum composition, and its functions;

WHEREAS, in recognition of the need to employ a Whole-of-Society, inclusive approach, and the implementation of good governance through citizen participation in disaster risk reduction and management there is a need to ensure the membership of accredited Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) and private sector;

WHEREAS, through the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issuance of Memorandum Circular 2022-083 dated June 15, 2022, which prescribes guidelines on the accreditation of CSOs and selection of representatives to the Local Special Bodies, the Davao Oriental Provincial People's Council passed and approved PPC Resolution No. 1 series of 2023, entitled: *A Resolution endorsing to Honorable Niño Sotero L. Uy, Jr., Governor of the Province of Davao Oriental, for his kind approval on the membership of Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) in the Local Special Bodies (LSBs)*;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NIÑO SOTERO L. UY, JR., Governor of the Province of Davao Oriental, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the **Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (PDRRMC)** with the following composition and functions, and designate accredited Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) as members.

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION – The membership of the PDRRMC shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS – The Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council shall have the following functions:

- 2.1 Approve, monitor, and evaluate the implementation of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (PDRRMP) and annually review, test, and develop the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
- 2.2 Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs, and budgets as a strategy for sustainable development and poverty reduction;
- 2.3 Recommend the implementation of Pre-Emptive and Forced evacuation of local residents, if necessary;
- 2.4 Convene the PDRRMC once every three (3) months or as often as necessary;
- 2.5 Perform such other functions that are incidental to and are necessary for the performance of disaster risk reduction and management;
- 2.6 The Provincial DRRM Officer shall serve as the PDRRMC Secretariat; and
- 2.7 All PDRRMC member agencies shall assign and designate their permanent DRRM Focal Person.

SECTION 3. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CSOS COUNCIL MEMBERS – The CSO Council Members shall have the following responsibilities;

- 3.1 Participate in all activities of the Provincial DRRM Council, such as but not limited to meetings, conferences, policy review and formulation, training, and capacity building programs, advocacy campaigns, response, and monitoring;
- 3.2 Provide updates on activities to the Council during meetings;
- 3.3 Disseminate information on N/R/PDRRMC activities to its members;
- 3.4 Provide the PDRRMC a copy of reports on its plans, accomplishments, and financial statements highlighting its contributions relative to the Provincial DRRM Plan;
- 3.5 Provide the Council an updated information sheet containing its list of executive officers at the start of each year;
- 3.6 Coordinate with and assist in the conduct of DRRM activities of the PDRRMC;
- 3.7 Participate in the monitoring of DRRM activities of the PDRRMC;

- 3.8 Provide assistance to the PDRRMC in the form of technical and resource mobilization; and
- 3.9 Shall participate in operational activities relating to the design, financing, and execution of programs, in accordance with applicable regulations and specific agreements negotiated for this purpose by the PDRRMC.

SECTION 4. CREATION OF FOUR (4) THEMATIC AREA CLUSTERS – There shall be created four (4) Thematic Area Clusters under the PDRRMC and shall be headed by the following:

SECTION 5. DUTIES AND FUNCTION OF THEMATIC AREA CLUSTERS – Respective thematic clusters shall have the following functions:


- 5.1 Conduct cluster meetings once every three (3) months prior to the conduct of PDRRMC meetings or as often as necessary;
- 5.2 Provide inputs on DRRM-CCA development plans aligned with their agencies’ mandates;
- 5.3 Work with other implementing partners within the context of coordination, collaboration, and partnership; and
- 5.4 Consolidate accomplishment reports of cluster members and implementing partners and submit/present during the PDRRMC meetings.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE – Previous executive issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, superseded, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason, any part or provision of this Order shall be found unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. Effectivity – This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon approval.
