A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE HANS MENZI MANSION (GOVERNOR'S MANSION/ RESIDENCE) LOCATED IN BARANGAY DON MARTIN MARUNDAN, CITY OF MATI, DAVAO ORIENTAL, AS CULTURAL PROPERTY OF DAVAO ORIENTAL.

WHEREAS, in his letter, dated August 20, 2024, the Honorable Governor Niño Sotero L. Uy Jr. has requested the August Body for the passage of a legislative action relative to the above-mentioned subject matter, docketed as Communication No. 17-1049-2024;

WHEREAS, Hans Menzi Mansion was built in 1950. This historical landmark embodies the province's rich history and architectural heritage. Its preservation would benefit the province through tourism development, educational opportunities, and community engagement;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10066, otherwise known as the "National Cultural Heritage Act of 2009", provides among others for the protection, preservation, conservation and promotion of the historical and cultural heritage of our nation;

WHEREAS, Sections 14, 15, 16 and 17, Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution declare that "the State shall foster the preservation, enrichment and dynamic evolution of a Filipino culture xxx";

WHEREAS, the Constitution likewise mandates the conservation, development, promotion and popularization of the nation's historical, cultural heritage and resources, as well as artistic creations and further provides that all the country's artistic and historic wealth constitutes the cultural treasure of the nation and shall be under the protection of the State which may regulate its disposition;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the above cited premises, the 17th SP declares the **HANS MENZI MANSION** (Governor's Mansion/ Residence) located in Barangay Don Martin Marundan, City of Mati, Davao Oriental, as Cultural Property of Davao Oriental;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Harold A. Montes, duly seconded by SP Members Rotchie M. Ravelo, Andy A. Monday, and Daud V. Linsag, it was
